# Did White House Chinada Geo-Impotence Embolden Iran to Plan Terrorism Strikes on American Soil?

Talk is not only cheap it's dangerous to the interests and long term health of democracy, the rule of law, human rights and free market capitalism when done in the international relations arena where there are ideological battles with their opposite. And it's especially problematic for reformers who seek the aid of those committed to what the coalition pursues. On the **fifth** week anniversary of the "deal is done" communiqué America's three largest national television networks and two cable stations showed they were of the same mind in full agreement - with the Canadian lawyer taking possession of his entitlements.

There are many serious consequences to the peace, security and prosperity of the 21<sup>st</sup> century because U.S. administrations have been ignoring, coddling or facilitating that which maintains Chinada's control of America's northern neighbour and Beijing with Ottawa's assistance insidiously and dominos-style spreading totalitarian political and corporate cultures throughout the world. The geo-impotence of two successive White Houses has gotten around through diplomatic channels and can't but lead rogue states like Iran to think they can strike the U.S. militarily or otherwise.

#### Iran said greater threat, while al-Qaida declines

WASHINGTON (AP) - Top U.S. intelligence officials on Tuesday asserted that Iran has the means to build a nuclear weapon but has not yet decided to follow through, in contrast to Israel's insistence that time is running out to stop Iran from developing such a weapon.

But Iran is likely to strike out at U.S. interests if it feels threatened, Director of National Intelligence James Clapper told the Senate

Intelligence Committee in an annual report to Congress on threats facing America.

Citing last year's thwarted Iranian plot to kill the Saudi ambassador in the U.S., "some Iranian officials - probably including Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei ... are now more willing to conduct an attack in the United States in response to real or perceived U.S. actions that threaten the regime," Clapper said.

That it's been a year since the genesis of the MK-Ultra Gate scandal and still private sector partners, including America's Fourth Estate, haven't taken a really bold step against Obama *et al.* also demonstrates weakness. This circumstance is sure a far cry from the Reagan - Thatcher era which successfully battled what Chinada now represents.

Five weeks to the day after the *quantum* was said to be resolved - February 1st - involves another auspicious anniversary. It was on this day in 2006 President Bush made his deceit and manipulations even more nefarious. He and his co-colluders ordered live fire rounds to be directed at Canadian diplomatic in Baghdad's Green Zone to make the coalition think his administration was going to be tough on the Conservative government that had just been elected in Canada after thirteen years of Liberal rule. That it's six years later and there hasn't been one of what should have been many successive "concrete steps" to address Chinada belligerence leaves rogue states viewing the United States and its coalition allies as weak and indecisive.



Then for the interview of his special guest, Howard Stern, he taped a sign to the front of his desk that read "Brad Pitt" to keep the comedic jab alive and to further demonstrate he, his producers and staff were dedicating the milestone in part to the Canadian.





Brad Pitt didn't show up on 'The Late Show', but instead agreed to appear on 'The Daily Show' and he chose to be there attired in *quantum*. He and the host executed B-Clinton M.s to draw attention to MK-Ultra Gate.

In between the morning and evening's *ad idem* CBS news producers delivered such a convincing two-part communiqué on the issue, it brought

Also in the speech are indications the Canadian can expect twice what was originally agreed upon; the doubled portion being for what can only be concluded as "foreign aid" to help finance Canadian reform and accountability.

Extend the tuition tax credit we started that saves middle-class families thousands of dollars. And give more young people the chance to earn their way through college [28:34-38: Biden: Cowell M.] by doubling the number of work-study jobs in the next **five** years. [...] We've already announced over 500 reforms, and just a fraction of them will save business and citizens [44:19: Boehner: Prince Harry M.] more than \$10 billion over the next **five** years.
